TRAVEL ADVISORY UPDATE

Date Issued: 9 JULY 2009, 11.45AM (AEST) replacing previous advice

This update removes advice for residents of Australia/NZ as it is now contained in a separate advice from the insurer, Mondial Assistance. There is a further update to the alert by the World Health Organisation.

Incident Summary Mexico - Influenza Outbreak (Swine Flu)

In late April 2009 Mexican authorities declared that there was a serious outbreak of influenza in several states, including Mexico City, the State of Mexico, Oaxaca, San Luis Potosi, Baja California and Tamulipas. According to the World Health Organisation (WHO) this appears to have been isolated from a new strain of H1N1 Influenza A.

Effective July 2009, the World Health Organisation (<u>www.who.int</u>) raised its alert to Pandemic Alert 6, 'Widespread Human Infection'. You can follow WHO updates on Twitter <u>http://twitter.com/whonews</u>

Am I covered if I want to cancel my trip to Mexico or one of the affected areas?

At this time, there is no provision for cancellation, rearrangement or curtailment because of the Swine Flu outbreak.

Exceptions:

Canadian policy holders will have provision to claim for cancellation or interruption as long as the travel advisory was issued after the insurance was issued ie, insurance must have been issued prior to 24 April. There is no provision to claim for cancellation or interruption expenses if they purchased after 24 April.

IHI, Millstream and Mondial USA (Access America) do not cover cancellation/curtailment or rearrangement costs for outbreaks of this nature. Please refer to your policy wording available on your members' page for more information.

For those considering travel to these areas who have not yet purchased a policy

You will not be covered for cancellation/curtailment or rearrangement costs at any time.
